DA/C# If she's playing him for a fool, he's the last one to know B- D/A

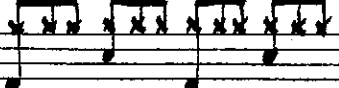
GA Lovin' eyes don't ever see DA
